## Emergency Visits and Severe Emergency Patients

The number of patients with a severe illness among those visiting the ER

## Definitions

- Severe illnesses: A list of illnesses designated by the Ministry of Health and Welfare as having a high mortality rate or being influenced with respect to the prognosis by an early treatment.


## Result

May 1, 2003 - December 31, 2022 -O-O


## Interpretation

- The number of patients visiting continued to increase, but decreased due to flexible operation in response to COVID-19 in 2020.
- The number of patients with a severe illness among all patients is also increasing, and the percentage of severe emergency patients against all patients has also risen from $2.5 \%$ in 2003 to $5.4 \%$ in 2010 to $18.3 \%$ in 2022.


## Improvement

- Efforts are taken for SNUBH to play the role as the regional emergency medical center by preventing any delay in treating the severe emergency patients and providing high-quality treatments.
- The role as the ultimate treatment institution of the region should be reinforced by providing more proactive treatments to the severe emergency patients.
